The goal is the achievement of the “zero defect” quality directly in the manufacturing process, fulfilling customer requirements for all quality parameters (container integrity, very low level of glass particles, scratches, absence of any biological contaminations, cosmetic aspect, definition of dedicated SOPs to cover all critical sub-processes, special training (with final qualification) of all operators involved in the production).

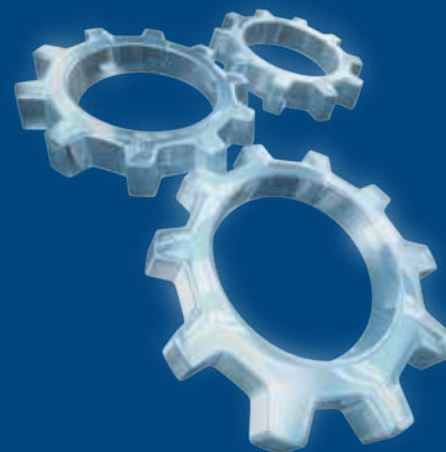
